BIBLE STORY: The Story of the Shepherds

FAITH DECLARATION: God has a plan for my life.

CONNECT

INSTRUCTIONS:

Say: This month we are learning all about God's Plan. Can you say, "God's Plan?" Way to go! The Bible tells us that we should trust in God and the plans that He has for us. That even when we don't know what tomorrow looks like, God does.

BIG IDEA: This is where we help kids apply what they learned to their personal lives. **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Read Question 1: Who's plans are better than our own plans? (God's)
 - Apply: Point up above.
- Read Question 2: Where was Jesus born? (Bethlehem)
 - Apply: Pretend to hold baby Jesus.
- Read Question 3: What did all the angels do when they appeared? (They sang.)
 - Apply: Pretend to sing like an angel.
- Read Question 4: What did the Angel tell the shepherds? (Don't be afraid.)
 - Apply: Cover your eye's like you are scared.
- Read Question 5: After seeing Jesus what did the Shepherds do? (They told everyone about Jesus.)
 - Apply: Whisper "Jesus" in your friend's ear.

PRAY

BIG IDEA: This is our opportunity to teach kids that part of having a relationship with Jesus is talking to Him.

INSTRUCTIONS: Talk to the kids about why we pray, ask for prayer requests, and ask them to pray out loud.

SAY IT AGAIN

Practice the memory verse or even try learning the Memory Verse Rap.
